ABOUT THE PLACE

The Srinagar to Manali bike trip is an exhilarating and scenic adventure through the heart of the Himalayas, covering around 1500km of rugged roads and breathtaking landscapes. Starting from Srinagar, you ride through the lush valleys of Kashmir, navigating the challenging Zoji La Pass, which leads to the historic town of Kargil, and then onward through Lamayuru and Fotu La passes to reach Leh, onwards you will proceed to conquer the infamous passes of Ladkha. The route continues to Manali via the infamous Atal Tunnel offering spectacular views of snow-capped peaks, high-altitude deserts, and dramatic mountain vistas.

SRINAGAR TO KARGIL VIA ZOJI LA /SONMARG

Difficulty Level: Moderate Altitude shift: 5,000 ft to 8760 ft

- After breakfast, begin your ride from Srinagar to Kargil.
- Stop at the stunning Sonamarg (if time permits) for a quick visit.
- Visit the Kargil War Memorial to pay homage to the brave soldiers who defended our nation.
- End your day with a relaxing stay at the Kargil hotel followed by a delicious dinner.



KARGIL TO LEH VIA FOTU LA

Difficulty Level: Moderate Altitude shift: 8760 ft to 9,000 ft

- After breakfast, depart from Kargil to Leh.
- Cross the scenic Namkila Pass and Fotula Pass.
- En route, witness:
 - The confluence of the Zaskar and Indus Rivers at Sangam.
 - Magnetic Hill, Pathar Sahib Gurudwara, and the Hall of Fame Museum (If time Permits)
- End the day with a delightful dinner and overnight stay at Leh.



LEH TO NUBRA VALLEY VIA KHARDUNG LA

Difficulty Level: Moderate Altitude Shift: 9,000 ft to 10,000 ft

- After breakfast, begin an exciting drive to Nubra Valley via Khardung-La Pass, the highest motorable road in the world.
- Descend into Nubra Valley and explore the white sand dunes of Hunder.
- Experience a unique double-humped Bactrian camel ride in the desert.
- Enjoy a peaceful night under the starry sky at a campsite in Nubra Valley.



NUBRA VALLEY TO PANGONG VIA SHYOK

Difficulty Level: Moderate Altitude Shift: 13,860 ft to 14,000 ft

- After breakfast, embark on a scenic drive to Pangong Lake via the Shyok River.
- Arrive at the stunning Pangong Lake, famous for its ever-changing colors, from blue to green to red.
- Visit iconic Bollywood spots from movies like 3 Idiots and take photos with the famous yellow scooter.
- Spend the night at a lakeside camp, with the serene Pangong Lake as your backdrop.



PANGONG TSO TO HANLE VIA REZANG LA

Difficulty Level: Extreme Altitude Shift: 14,000 ft to 19,024 ft

- Begin your journey along the cobalt shores of Pangong Tso, passing through Maan, Merak, and Chushul.
- Pay tribute at the Rezang-La War Memorial, honoring the heroes of the 1962 Indo-China War.
- Continue to the remote village of Hanle, home to the world's second-largest observatory.
- Experience a surreal night sky in Hanle, where galaxies and constellations shine brightly.



HANLE TO UMLING LA - HANLE

Difficulty Level: Moderate Altitude shift: 14,000 ft to 13,860 ft

- Start your exciting ride to Umling La Pass, the highest motorable road in the world.
- Enjoy the stunning views of the rugged terrain and take photos to capture your achievement.
- Spend some peaceful time in meditation amidst the calm surroundings.
- Head back to Hanle for a delicious dinner and an overnight stay.



HANLE TO TSO MORIRI

Difficulty Level: High

Altitude shift: 13,860 ft to 10,000 ft

- After breakfast, begin your ride, taking in the beauty of Puga Springs.
- Enjoy the changing landscapes as you continue your journey towards Tso Moriri.
- End the day with a hearty dinner and a peaceful night's rest at your accommodation.



TSO MORIRI TO SARCHU

Difficulty Level: Moderate Altitude shift: 10,000 ft to 9,000 ft

- Begin the challenging ride to Sarchu.
- The route takes you past Tsokar Lake, offering both challenges and stunning views.
- Conquer Naki La and Lachung La, crossing the famous More Plains and tackle the famous 21 hairpin loops of Gata Loops
- Arrive at the campsite, where stories of the day's adventures and excitement for the journey ahead bring everyone together.



SARCHU TO MANALI VIA BARALACHA LA PASS

Difficulty Level: Moderate Altitude shift: 9,000 ft to 8760 ft

- Get ready for an adventurous bike trip today.
- Cross Baralacha La.
- Enjoy a quick meal at a local dhaba or roadside café.
- Ride through the scenic beauty of Keylong and the lush greenery of Solang Valley.
- Pass through the Atal Tunnel, one of the world's longest highway tunnels at high altitude.
- Arrive in Manali for an overnight stay in a hotel.

Difficulty Level: Moderate Altitude shift: 8760 ft to 5,000 ft

Important Points

- Be advised that hospitality services may vary significantly due to the remote nature of these areas.
- Rental bikes may have a usage history ranging from 20,000 to 30,000 kilometers, resulting in varying conditions.
- The exact timeline of the itinerary may change due to unforeseen circumstances.
- If a breakdown occurs, a backup and support team will provide assistance.
- Be aware that food taste may vary, especially at high altitudes where cooking can be challenging.
- In remote areas, hot water availability may be limited due to government restrictions on electricity.
- Accommodations may involve split stays due to limited inventory at properties
- Expect delayed response times from hotel/camp staff due to limited personnel.
- Adhere to the trip captain's guidance to successfully complete sightseeing and the journey.
- The trip captain reserves the right to terminate individuals or groups from the trip due to misconduct.
- Standard sizes for riding gear are available, with limited options for plus sizes and small sizes.
- Trip operators and captains may change the itinerary at any time due to weather conditions.
- Be prepared for potential road closures due to snow, landslides, or water overflow; alternative transportation may be used to continue the itinerary.

- Due to limited inventory in Hanle, accommodations can be provided on a triple and quad sharing basis.
- A security deposit of ₹8,000 is required per bike at the time of rental, in case of any damages to the bike, the repair costs will be deducted from the security deposit. If the damage costs exceed the deposit amount, the renter will be responsible for paying the additional charges.
- Requests to early and late checkin/checkout time in Manali or Srinagar are not possible. If you wish to explore the city, you may leave your luggage in the cloakroom or at the reception. However, please note that this is at your own risk.
- Please ensure you are ready at the designated boarding point at the given time. If you miss the bus due to delay on your part, we will not be held responsible, Volvo buses can breakdowns. In such cases, please remain calm. We will arrange a supplementary vehicle as soon as possible to minimize inconvenience
- Timings and distance mentioned in the itinerary is taken on general case scenario, however it can be changed.
- Accommodation, driver and trip captain details will be provided over WhatsApp group created 3-7 days before your departure.

Tips for a comfortable Journey

- Drink plenty of water to remain hydrated throughout the trip.
- Trolley bags are not allowed, it is advised to carry only rucksack bags. penalty of 500 per kg will be charge if you do not have rucksack bags.
- It is advisable to take Diamox as prescribed by your healthcare provider, as abrupt
- On Day 3 and Day 6, participants should anticipate challenging riding conditions due to substantial altitude increases; adherence to recommended health protocols is strongly advised.

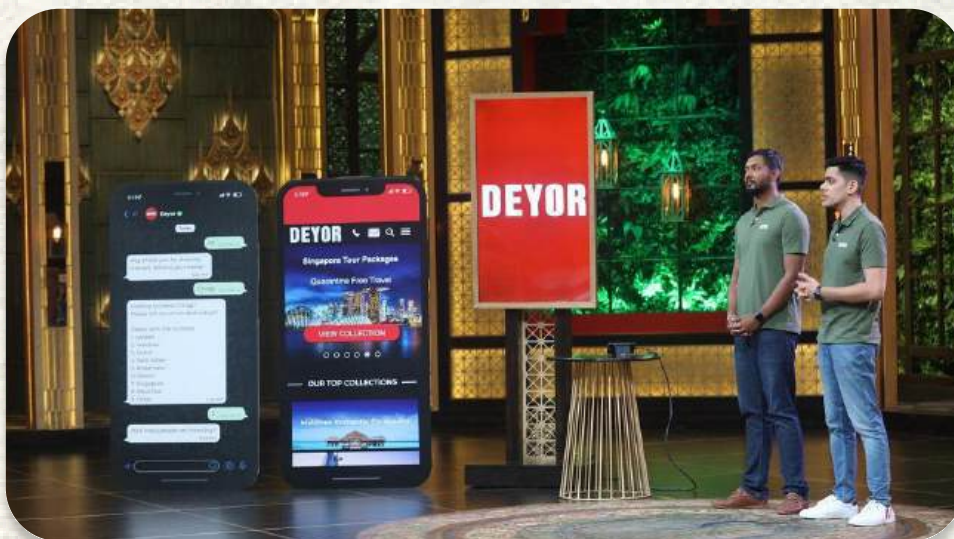
