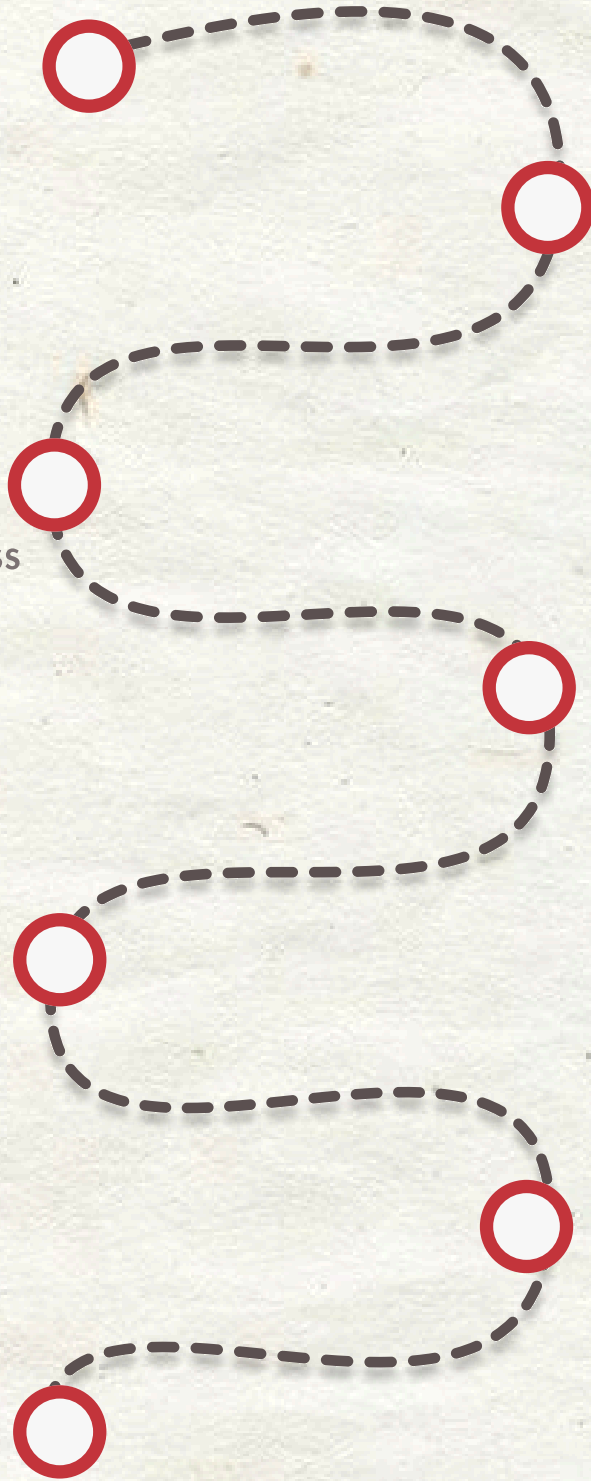

ARRIVAL IN LEH | WELCOME TO THE TOP OF THE WORLD

- Arrive at Leh Kushok Bakula Rimpochee Airport.
- Check-in to the designated hotel and take time to acclimatize to the high altitude.
- In the evening, explore the Leh Market for local handicrafts, visit the historic Leh Palace, and enjoy a peaceful sunset at Shanti Stupa (on your own).
- Return to the hotel for the dinner.



LEH TO SHAM VALLEY | EXPLORING BORDERS OF LEH

Distance: 90 km round trip | Travel Time: 4-5 hours

- After breakfast, embark on a ride to Sham Valley.
- Visit the mesmerizing Confluence of the Zaskar and Indus Rivers, the highest river rafting point in the world.
- Explore the Hall of Fame, a museum dedicated to Indian soldiers.
- Experience the gravitational anomaly at Magnetic Hill, where vehicles appear to roll uphill in neutral gear.
- Pay homage at Gurudwara Pathar Sahib and enjoy a langar.
- Return to Leh and enjoy a hearty dinner.



LEH TO NUBRA VALLEY VIA KHARDUNG-LA PASS | CONQUER THE MIGHTY KHARDUNG-LA

Distance: 130 km | Travel Time: 5-6 hours

- Enjoy breakfast and gear up for the ride to Nubra Valley via Khardung-La Pass, the world's second highest motorable road.
- As you descend, reach the scenic Nubra Valley, known for its white sand dunes.
- Experience a ride on the unique double-humped Bactrian camels (if time permits).
- Settle into your campsite and enjoy dinner under a star-studded sky.



NUBRA VALLEY TO TURTUK | INDIA'S LAST VILLAGE

Distance: 230 km | Travel Time: 6-7 hours

- Post breakfast, ride to Turtuk, the last Indian village before the Pakistan-controlled Gilgit-Baltistan region.
- Explore the unique Balti culture, distinct from the rest of Ladakh, and admire the verdant apricot orchards.
- Stroll through narrow lanes and marvel at the stunning views of dramatic valleys and rugged peaks.
- Return to Nubra Valley and relax at the campsite with a delicious dinner.



NUBRA VALLEY TO PANGONG LAKE | RELIVE THE BOLLYWOOD MOMENTS

Distance: 230 km | Travel Time: 6-7 hours

- After breakfast, set out on a scenic drive to Pangong Lake via Shyok River.
- Arrive at the breathtaking Pangong Lake, known for its ever-changing colors from blue to green to red.
- Visit iconic spots from Bollywood movies like 3 Idiots and take photos with the famous yellow scooter.
- Spend the night in a lakeside camp with the serene Pangong Lake as your backdrop.



PANGONG LAKE TO LEH | EXCURSION TO RANCHO SCHOOL

Distance: 160 km | Travel Time: 6-7 hours

- Wake up to the tranquil views of Pangong Lake.
- Begin your return journey to Leh via Chang La Pass, the third-highest motorable road in the world.
- En route, visit the Thiksey Monastery, a 12-story Tibetan monastery with stunning architecture and artifacts (if time permits).
- Make a quick stop at the famous Rancho School (Druk White Lotus School) for a nostalgic Bollywood moment.
- Arrive in Leh and relax with a delicious dinner at the hotel.



DEPARTURE FROM LEH | GOODBYE, HIMALAYAS

- After breakfast, check out from the hotel.
- Transfer to Leh Airport for your onward journey, bidding farewell to the majestic mountains and the adventure of a lifetime.

Important Points

- Be advised that hospitality services may vary significantly due to the remote nature of these areas.
- Rental bikes may have a usage history ranging from 20,000 to 30,000 kilometers, resulting in varying conditions.
- The exact timeline of the itinerary may change due to unforeseen circumstances.
- If a breakdown occurs, a backup and support team will provide assistance.
- Be aware that food taste may vary, especially at high altitudes where cooking can be challenging.
- In remote areas, hot water availability may be limited due to government restrictions on electricity.
- Accommodations may involve split stays due to limited inventory at properties
- Expect delayed response times from hotel/camp staff due to limited personnel.
- Adhere to the trip captain's guidance to successfully complete sightseeing and the journey.
- The trip captain reserves the right to terminate individuals or groups from the trip due to misconduct.
- Standard sizes for riding gear are available, with limited options for plus sizes and small sizes.
- Trip operators and captains may change the itinerary at any time due to weather conditions.
- Be prepared for potential road closures due to snow, landslides, or water overflow; alternative transportation may be used to continue the itinerary.

- Due to limited inventory in Hanle, accommodations can be provided on a triple and quad sharing basis.
- A security deposit of ₹8,000 is required per bike at the time of rental, in case of any damages to the bike, the repair costs will be deducted from the security deposit. If the damage costs exceed the deposit amount, the renter will be responsible for paying the additional charges.
- Requests to early and late checkin/checkout time in Manali or Srinagar are not possible. If you wish to explore the city, you may leave your luggage in the cloakroom or at the reception. However, please note that this is at your own risk.
- Please ensure you are ready at the designated boarding point at the given time. If you miss the bus due to delay on your part, we will not be held responsible, Volvo buses can breakdowns. In such cases, please remain calm. We will arrange a supplementary vehicle as soon as possible to minimize inconvenience
- Timings and distance mentioned in the itinerary is taken on general case scenario, however it can be changed.
- Accommodation, driver and trip captain details will be provided over WhatsApp group created 3-7 days before your departure.

Tips for a comfortable Journey

- Drink plenty of water to remain hydrated throughout the trip.
- Trolley bags are not allowed, it is advised to carry only rucksack bags. penalty of 500 per kg will be charge if you do not have rucksack bags.
- It is advisable to take Diamox as prescribed by your healthcare provider, as abrupt
- On Day 3 and Day 6, participants should anticipate challenging riding conditions due to substantial altitude increases; adherence to recommended health protocols is strongly advised.

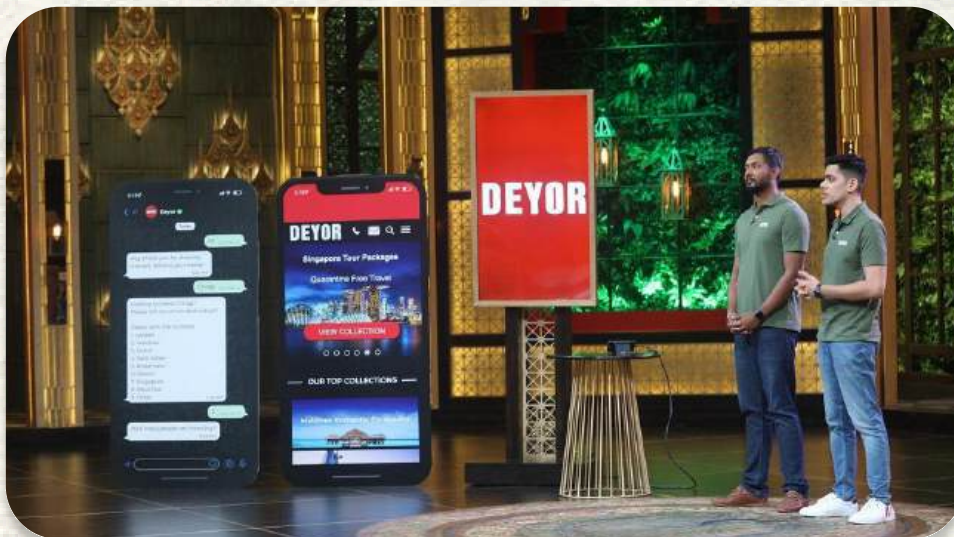
