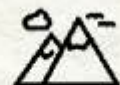

# Overview

Your journey begins with arrival in Leh, where you acclimatize and explore local attractions like Leh Palace and Shanti Stupa. The next leg takes you from Leh to Kargil (220 km) via Magnetic Hill, Gurudwara Pathar Sahib, and Lamayuru's Moonland, crossing Fotu La (4,108 m) and Namika La (3,700 m) before reaching Kargil for an overnight stay. From Kargil to Padum (230 km), you travel through the breathtaking Suru Valley, visiting Panikhar, Parkachik, and Rangdum Monastery, before crossing Penzi La Pass (4,401 m) to enter Zaskar Valley. After exploring Padum, you head towards Purne, the gateway to the famous Phugtal Monastery, where you can take a short trek. The journey continues from Purne to Sarchu, crossing the remote Shingo La Pass (5,091 m), descending into Lahaul before rejoining the Leh-Manali Highway. From Sarchu to Leh, you cross major passes like Baralacha La, Lachung La, Nakee La, and Tanglang La, experiencing high-altitude landscapes before concluding your adventure in Leh for departure.

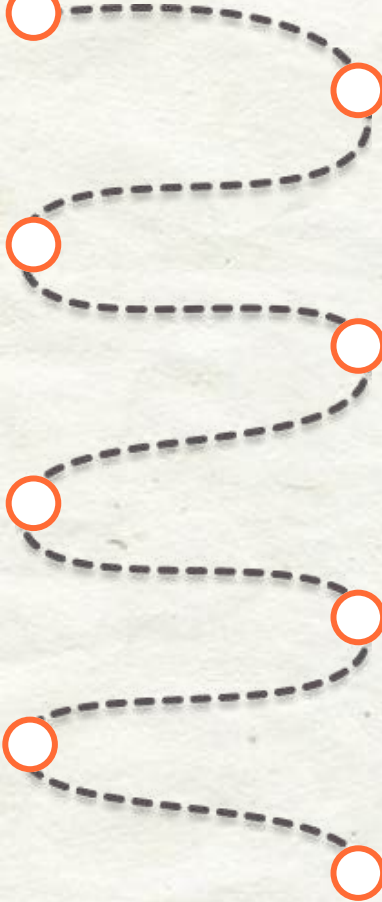

## **ARRIVAL IN LEH**

- Evening Activities:

  - Explore Leh Palace.
  - Enjoy a panoramic sunset view from Shanti Stupa.
- Overnight stay in Leh.



## LEH TO KARGIL

- Distance: 220 km round trip
- Travel Time: 5–6 hours
- Meals: Breakfast & Dinner
- Breakfast at hotel.
- Journey to Kargil with multiple stops:
  - Magnetic Hill – Experience the optical illusion.
  - Gurudwara Pathar Sahib – A revered Sikh pilgrimage site.
  - Sangam Point – Confluence of the Indus and Zaskar rivers.
  - Lamayuru Monastery – Famous for its "Moonland" landscape.
- Drive through mountain passes:
  - Fotu La (4,108m) – Highest pass on the Srinagar-Leh highway.
  - Namika La (3,700m) – Scenic mountain pass.
- Visit Kargil War Memorial (Dras) – Honoring the martyrs of the 1999 Kargil War.
- Checkin hotel and rest.
- Overnight stay in Kargil.



## **KARGIL TO PADUM**

- Distance: 230KM round trip
- Travel Time: 9–10 hours
- Meals: Breakfast & Dinner
- Early start for a long and adventurous drive through Suru Valley.
- Pass through picturesque villages like Panikhar.
- Witness Parkachik Glacier – A massive hanging glacier.
- Stop at Rangdum Monastery – An isolated Buddhist monastery amidst barren landscapes.
- Cross Pensi La Pass (4,400m) – Offers stunning views of Drang Drung Glacier, one of Ladakh's largest glaciers.
- Descend into Zaskar Valley and reach Padum, the administrative hub.
- Overnight stay in Padum.



## PADUM SIGHTSEEING

- Meals: Breakfast & Dinner
- Explore the cultural and spiritual heritage of Zanskar.
- Visit Karsha Monastery – The largest monastery in the valley with panoramic views of Padum.
- Explore Stongdey Monastery – Perched on a hill, offering stunning scenery.
- Visit Sani Monastery – One of the oldest monasteries in Ladakh.
- Experience village life in Padum – Interact with friendly locals.
- Relax in the evening.
- Overnight stay in Padum.

- Distance: 250 km
- Travel Time: 3–4 hours
- Meals: Breakfast & Dinner
  
- Breakfast at the guesthouse.
- Scenic drive from Padum to Purne, passing through:
  - Ichar Village – A picturesque settlement.
  - Lungnak Valley – Stunning landscapes with barren mountains and flowing rivers.
- Explore Purne – Experience the local culture.
- Relax and enjoy local sightseeing instead of the usual trek to Phugtal Monastery.
- Evening at leisure.
- Overnight stay in Purne.



## **PURNE TO SARCHU**

- Distance: 270 km round trip
- Travel Time: 11-12 hours
- Meals: Breakfast & Dinner
  
- Early departure from Purne for a long journey to Sarchu.
- Cross major high-altitude passes:
  - Baralacha La Pass – Known for unpredictable weather and stunning vistas.
  - Shinku La Pass – Offers breathtaking mountain views.
- Arrive in Sarchu, the border between Ladakh and Himachal Pradesh.
- Settle into a high-altitude campsite and experience an adventurous night.
- Enjoy sleeping under the starry sky.
- Overnight stay in Sarchu.



## SARCHU TO LEH

- Distance: 250 km
- Travel Time: 8–9 hours
- Meals: Breakfast & Dinner
  
- Scenic drive back to Leh.
- Navigate the famous Gata Loops – 21 sharp hairpin bends.
- Cross Tanglang La (5,328m) – The second-highest motorable pass in the world.
- Pass through Pang – A picturesque high-altitude plateau.
- Drive across More Plains – A vast 40 km-long stretch of flat land at high altitude.
- Enjoy breathtaking landscapes along the journey.
- Arrive in Leh by evening, check into the hotel, and rest.
- Overnight stay in Leh.

# Tips for a comfortable Journey

- Drink plenty of water to remain hydrated throughout the trip.

- It is advisable to take Diamox as prescribed by your healthcare provider, as abrupt changes in altitude may have detrimental effects on your health.
- Low network connectivity may affect communication during the trip, inform your dear ones at home and in trip mates whenever possible.
- For more details please refer to things to carry.

## Important Points

- Be advised that hospitality services may vary significantly due to the remote nature of these areas.
- Rental bikes may have a usage history ranging from 20,000 to 30,000 kilometers, resulting in varying conditions.
- The exact timeline of the itinerary may change due to unforeseen circumstances.
- If a breakdown occurs, a backup and support team will provide assistance.
- Be aware that food taste may vary, especially at high altitudes where cooking can be challenging.
- In remote areas, hot water availability may be limited due to government restrictions on electricity.
- Accommodations may involve split stays due to limited inventory at properties
- Expect delayed response times from hotel/camp staff due to limited personnel.
- Adhere to the trip captain's guidance to successfully complete sightseeing and the journey.
- The trip captain reserves the right to terminate individuals or groups from the trip due to misconduct.
- Standard sizes for riding gear are available, with limited options for plus sizes and small sizes.
